Rain-Out Rescheduling Policy for Major & Minor Leagues

January, 2010

Any and all attempts shall be made to play the game at its scheduled time. All teams to report to the field. The decision to play will be made at the field, based on field conditions and weather. All managers will be notified at 4 PM if the MYB Board decides to cancel that day's games.

	Any game that is rained-out on a weekday will be re-scheduled either for the immediate Friday or other available weekday time slot.
	Multiple day rain-outs will be managed by scheduling the oldest game first on the immediate Friday, first available time slot or Sunday practice time if necessary.
	If necessary, Friday's Minor League game will be played at 6:00pm at the MYA/Bise Field. A Major or Minor League game may also be played at 8:15pm for a maximum game time of 2 hours.
	A Saturday game that is rained-out will be re-scheduled for the immediate following Sunday.
	If all Saturday games are rained out the entire schedule will be moved to Sunday (weather permitting) and all practices will be cancelled.
	Every attempt will be made to re-play the game at the field it was originally scheduled to be played at.
	All games re-scheduled during the week will have a regular start time of 6:00pm.
	All games re-scheduled for a Sunday will be played at the field and practice time of the home team of the originally scheduled game.
	Any practice that is scheduled just prior to a Sunday game will be shortened to 1 ½ hours. The manager of the team scheduled to practice at that time must be notified of this change.
	Scheduling of umpires for a re-scheduled game must be done through the appointed umpire scheduler or the Umpire-in-Chief.

All time slots selected are at the discretion of the Player Agent of the respective league, Vice President of the league or President.
